



VLADIMIRS BUKOVSKIS

(Born in 1867, Petersburg; died in 1937, Riga)

Senator of the Civil Cassation Department of the Senate (1934–1937)

Education: Petersburg University, Faculty of Law; Doctor of Laws, University of Latvia.

Before the Senate: Trainee in the judicial system; Assistant secretary and secretary in Petersburg; Judge in Jelgava and Riga regional courts. During the First World War, he was a legal adviser to the military department and an adviser to the state. Senior Assistant Professor at the University of Latvia, Professor of the Department of Civil Procedure.

Additional information: Legal Adviser to the Ministry of Justice. Head of the Latvian Civil Law Drafting Commission. Author of the "Study Book on Civil Procedure" and many publications. Participated in the organization of the Baltic Law Office.
