(Born in 1869, Riga; died in 1937, Riga)

Senator of the Administrative Department of the Senate (1921–1922)

Education: Petersburg University, Faculty of Law.

Before the Senate: Worked for the Russian Ministry of Justice in Petersburg; Editor of the Codification Department and Assistant Secretary of State in the Russian State Council; Senior Editor of the Codification Department of the Russian Senate; Legal Adviser at the Riga City Council; Member of the Legal Consultation Department of the Ministry of Justice; Founder and Head of the Codification Department at the Ministry of Justice in Riga.

After the Senate: Head of the Codification Department of the Ministry of Justice and the Saeima (parliament); Minister of Justice.

Additional information: Member of the Consistory of the Russian Lutheran Church; Member of the Board of the Latvian Evangelical Lutheran Church.
