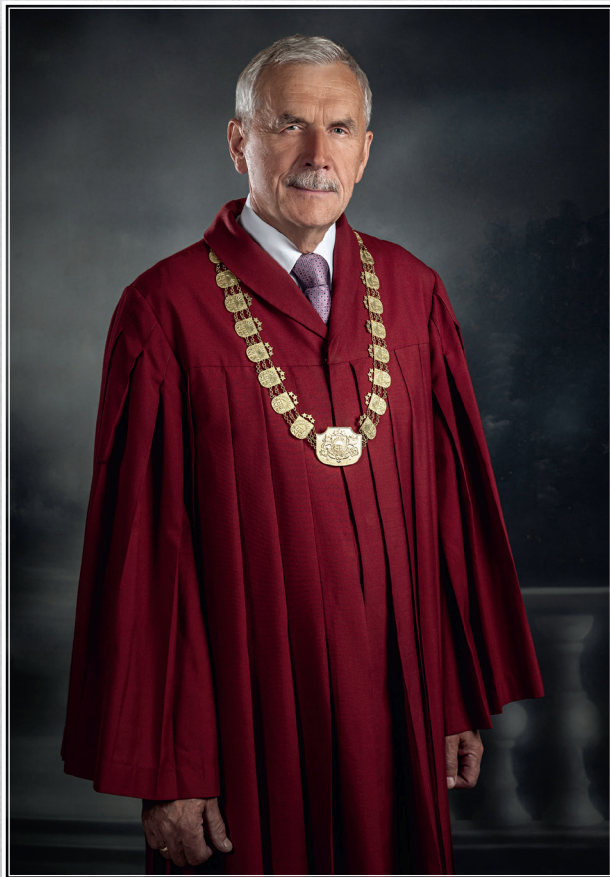


# Andris GULĀNS
