(Born in 1893, Blīdene parish; died in 1970, the USA)

Senator of the Civil Cassation Department of the Senate (1939–1940)

Education: *Moscow University, Faculty of Law.*

Before the Senate: *He has served in the Imperial Russian Army and anti-Bolshevik Denikin's Army. Foreign language correspondent for sales companies in Bulgaria. Magistrate, judge and deputy of the Regional Court.*

After the Senate: *Legal Adviser in the Directorate-General for Justice during the German occupation. In exile in Germany and the United States since 1944. Director of Baltic Communications at the rank of Major at the US Army Headquarters in Germany. Language teacher at the US Army Air Force School in Syracuse.*
