



## JĀNIS SKUDRE

(Born in 1889, Sauka parish; died in 1942, Sverdlovsk region)

### **Senator of the Criminal Cassation Department of the Senate (1934–1940)**

**Education:** *Moscow University, Faculty of Law; Kiev Commercial Institute.*

**Before the Senate:** *Assistant of Sworn Advocate in Daugavpils. He was mobilized in the Imperial Russian Army; Commander of Military Unit. Legal Adviser to the Central Committee for the Supply of Latvian Refugees; Commander of Military Unit in the Latvian army. Deputy of the Prosecutor in Daugavpils Regional Court; Judge in Jelgava Regional Court; Chair of Daugavpils Regional Court.*

**After the Senate:** *Arrested in 1941 and taken to prison camps in the Sverdlovsk region. Died before the sentence of death was pronounced.*

**Additional information:** *Chair of the Latvian Association of Judges. Head of the Section of the Latvian Chamber of Agriculture.*
